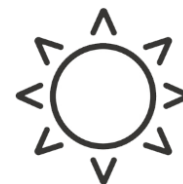

<b>Upper Primary Essay Writing</b>	9.30p.m. – 3.30p.m.	<b>Course Description</b> Students learn how to write the three main types of persuasive essays for success in the Selective School Test, Scholarship Tests and NAPLAN. Skills taught include planning, structure, forming an argument, presenting an opinion, academic vocabulary and how to use cohesive devices for clarity (among others).	\$295
<b>Monday the 10<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday the 12<sup>th</sup> of January (3 Days)</b>			
<b>Speed Writing 1</b>	9.00a.m. - 1.30p.m.	<b>Course Description</b> Students learn how to combine advanced literary language techniques and creative writing skills, by answering a variety of stimulus questions in test conditions within required timeframes. This course is excellent preparation for the writing components of Scholarship Tests, but is also highly recommended for students sitting the Selective School Test and NAPLAN. Both creative and persuasive writing topics are covered.	\$345
<b>Essential Text Types</b>	9.00a.m. - 1.30p.m.	<b>Course Description</b> Students learn how to write a variety of essential text types, including: formal & informal correspondence, advisory, review and newspaper report writing. This course is an absolute must for students sitting the new Selective School Test but is also highly recommended for students sitting Scholarships Tests and NAPLAN.	\$345
<b>Intensive Comprehension</b>	2.00p.m. – 4.00p.m.	<b>Course Description</b> This intensive skills-based course provides students with strategies for tackling key components of reading and comprehension, such as: understanding audience and purpose, finding the main idea of a text, evaluating lots of information, sequencing, gap fill, analysing poetry and inference. This course is great preparation for the new Selective School Test, Scholarship Tests and NAPLAN. However, this course is also fantastic for any students just aiming build solid reading and comprehension skills.	\$185

<b>Bubbles, Bats and Butterflies</b>	9.00a.m. - 1.30p.m.	<b>Course Description</b> This course expands on the elementary creative writing skills taught in Junior Primary and introduces students to more advanced level literary techniques. Participants will learn how to plan effectively, brainstorm atmospheric, interesting vocabulary and incorporate literary devices into their narrative writing.	\$345
