Courses	Times	Monday the 11 th and Tuesday the 12 th of July (2 Days)
Emilie and Emile	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description Junior Primary students are introduced to the creative skills of high-level narrative writing. Reading and comprehension strategies are also taught to consolidate students' understanding of the course content. This fun-filled program is always popular with junior writers!

MIDDLE PRIMARY (Stage 2)

Read, Write, Recite!	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description In this popular program, students are taught the elements of poetry: how to interpret, analyse and appreciate poetry, a variety of figurative poetry writing skills, and how to recite their work with confidence.
Wednesday the 13th and Thursday the 14th of July (2 Days)		
Middle Primary Essay Writing	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description Students are introduced to the elements of persuasive writing. Skills taught include planning, structure, forming an argument, presenting an opinion, appropriate vocabulary and how to use linking words and phrases for cohesion. This course is essential preparation for all standardised tests.

UPPER PRIMARY (Stage 3 - Selective/Scholarship)

Courses	Times	Monday the 11 th and Tuesday the 12 th of July (2 Days)
Colours	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description This course teaches high-level literary language techniques with an emphasis on the symbolism of colour. This course is excellent preparation for the writing components of tests such as Scholarship and Selective School.
Wednesday the 13th and Thursday the 14th of July (2 Days)		
Upper Primary Essay Writing	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description Students learn how to write the three main types of persuasive essays for success in standardised tests. Skills taught include planning, structure, forming an argument, presenting an opinion, academic vocabulary and how to use cohesive devices for clarity (among others). This is also highly recommended as high school preparation.

HIGH SCHOOL (Stages 4 & 5)

Courses	Times	Wednesday the 13 th and Thursday the 14 th of July (2 Days)
High School Essay Writing	9.00a.m. - 3.00p.m.	Course Description In this course, high school students learn how to write an extremely high-level persuasive essay for success in high school, standardised tests and beyond. A variety of advanced skills are taught covering various essay types and topics.
